### Payment and Refund

- MCYR budgets and counts on receiving all fees for day to day operations. For this reason, delinquency may result in your athlete not participating in practice or regattas until the account is brought current. For those paying in installments, a late charge of \$30 will be charged to your account if your account is not current within 15 days of the payment due date. If you are having difficulty making payments, please contact the MCYR Treasurer to review payment options.
