Additional Season Regattas	Food, Bus and Regatta Fees will be assessed as needed
Out of Town Regattas (invitation only)	\$375 estimate – varies based on venue • Includes bus, lodging, regatta fees, food and trailer transportation
Championship Regatta Fees (invitation only)	\$300 estimate – varies based on venue • Includes regattas fees and trailer transportation

Payment and Refund Information

- ✓ MCYR can only accept payments via PayPal. You do not need an account with PayPal to submit payment.
- ✓ Sibling discount only applies to athletes in the middle and high school program
- ✓ **MCYR budgets and counts on receiving all assessments for day to day operations.** For this reason, delinquency may result in your athlete not participating at practice or regattas until the account is brought current. For those paying in installments, a late charge of \$30.00 will be charged to your account if your account is not current within 15 days of the payment due date. If you are having difficulty making payments, please contact the MCYR Treasurer to review payment options.
- ✓ Insufficient fund fees (ISF) are the responsibility of the athlete's family and will be automatically added to the athlete's account.
- ✓ Any athlete who is injured or has special extenuating circumstances that prevents them from returning to the team will be considered for a refund of prepaid fees. This assumes the athlete's account is in good standing. The refund amount will be determined by the MCYR Board. In no case can any money received from donations or fundraisers be refunded. An athlete who quits, withdraws, or leaves the team due to disciplinary reasons will not be eligible to receive a refund.
